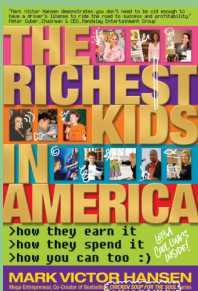


The CommEduCenter presents
