

## **Academic Plan**

Mill Springs Academy has always taught the way each student learns. We are committed to maintaining this practice no matter what the method of instruction might be. While the COVID-19 pandemic has created challenges, we believe that the demands placed on our academic program have also created opportunities to strengthen our program. GOAL: To increase accessibility to learning by offering various levels of instruction through multiple delivery methods using one primary tool, all while maintaining fidelity to the Georgia Performance Standards.

## **OBJECTIVES**

- Make learning more interactive increasing student engagement
- Differentiate instruction
- Improve overall accessibility to course content, assignments, and assessments
- Create tools that offer several ways for students to collaborate
- Enhance communication between Directors, teachers, students, and parents
- Support a paperless work environment









Mill Springs Academy faculty and staff are committed to continuing to collaborate with each student individually, teaching them how they learn best while providing a curriculum with academic rigor that challenges each student. Below are objectives and strategies the school has prepared in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

## **STRATEGIES**

- Develop unit lesson plans that focus on teaching state standards and student mastery of the standards. Each unit will include:
  - Goals and Objectives
  - Instructional materials
  - Instructional strategies
  - Assessment tools
- Develop hybrid lessons that allow students to self-select on-campus or eLearning.
  - Each class will start with direct teacher instruction
  - Students will be given application practice exercises and/or projects to work on their own
  - Teachers will be available to work with individual students' daily either in person or online
- Incorporate Project-Based learning as a key instructional practice.
  - Students are encouraged to choose the line of inquiry, resulting in higher engagement
  - Students are required to develop higher-level thinking skills by applying learned content to real-world situations
  - Students work is differentiated based on individual achievement
- Incorporate Guided Reading as an essential instructional practice.
  - Students work in small groups where the teacher provides explicit teaching and support for reading skills
  - Students read texts at their instructional level.
  - Students tap into background knowledge by reading text that reflects the content standards of the course.
- Utilize Google Classroom as the primary eLearning system.
  - Create and organize assignments by weaving together Google Docs, Drive, and Gmail
  - Allow teachers and students to provide real-time feedback
  - Improve class communications
  - Enhance organization by utilizing Drive folders
